



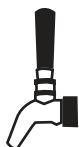

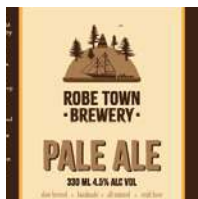


Bravo! - non-alcoholic beer <0.5% a/v

Yes, yes, we have made a non-alcoholic beer! Naturally fermented with a special yeast and dry-hopped with a bunch of modern fruity hops. It almost tastes like a real beer! In fact it is a real beer just with very, very low alcohol!

Robe Town Pale Ale - 4.5% a/v

Our most popular beer by a country mile is mild on the palate and very easy to drink. Made with subtle malt flavours and a gentle modern Australian hop aroma, our Pale Ale is a brilliant go-to beer and the perfect introduction to our craft beer range.

Bonnie Owl - session pale ale 3.8% a/v

A crisp and easy drinking session ale with fruity hop aromas of passionfruit. This is our lower alcohol, or session version of a dry-hopped pale ale. Named after Robe Town's first public house, the Bonnie Owl, located where the Robe Hotel now stands.

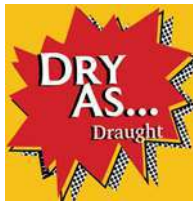
Longboard Lager - 4.5% a/v

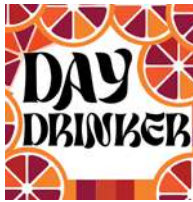


Dry Az... - low-carb, mid-strength draught 3.5%

Feel like a middy? Look no further! We have finally cracked the low-carb, mid-strength, draught style. It also happens to be dry as a dingo's ! Feel free to fill in the gaps. Super crisp, and locally made - it's a great beer from down here! Exclusively on tap only at Robe Town Brewery.

Day Drinker - blood orange blonde ale - 3 %

An experimental light summer blonde ale flavoured with zesty blood orange. Only available on tap for a limited time. A perfect thirst quencher with relatively low alcohol for any time of day!

Jetty Jumping - pale ale - 3 % a/v

A smashable low-alcohol pale ale with a nice bitter backbone and modern hoppy aromas. Refreshing as a cold plunge in summer. This is a single malt and single hop pale ale, made with barley from Taillem Bend and Enigma hops from Victoria. Take the plunge! you won't regret it!

The Moon Hop - extra pale ale - 5.3% a/v

A delicious, fruity and juicy extra pale ale made with extra malt and extra hops. Big flavours of guava, passionfruit, and pineapple. Big body and sweetness to boot. Drink fresh and serve at cellar temperature on cooler days, or chilled in the summer.

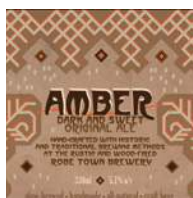


Brown Bear - small brown beer 2.4% a/v

Belgian brown table beer with a subtle hoppiness. Intriguing hints of caramel and nuttiness. This super-easy-drinking beer has an awesome flavour and crisp finish with only 0.6 standard drinks!

A full bodied ale made with heaps of dark caramelised malt and very low bitterness. It's all about the malt in this sweet and velvety dark ale. A go to for the crew at Robe Town, also one of two original recipes that helped launch Robe Town Brewery!

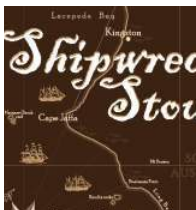


1869 (Lord's Dangerous Red) - Red IPA 6.1% a/v

A hearty red ale with big body, malty sweetness and a strong hoppy finish, Some would call it a Red IPA, we call it a dangerous red, because it is dangerously tasty! Brewed in honour of George Lord Snr., proprietor of the original Robe Town Brewery, established in Robe Town back in 1869.

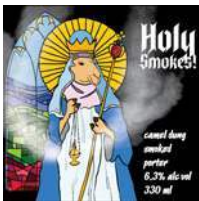


Shipwreck Stout - rich and smooth - 5% a/v

With an earthy aroma hinting at dark plums, coffee beans and smoky licorice, this textural stout brings a creamy flavour of woody espresso and chocolate, followed by a moreish finish. A well-balanced and easy-drinking stout that has converted many a non-stout drinker.

Holy Smokes! - camel dung smoked porter - 6.7 % a/v

A full bodied porter with heaps of flavour! Most notably the big smokey flavour from malt that we smoke over three days using local camel dung as the fuel source. Sweet malty flavours infused with a very pleasant savoury smokiness. This is seriously good shit!

Dark Sea - dark IPA - 7.5% a/v

A very dark, almost black, IPA with a rich malty backbone, moderate background bitterness and lots of fresh dry-hopped goodness. After first making this beer back in 2020, we've made it again and again and want to always have it available for ourselves and our customers. But mostly for ourselves :)

Solstice - Baltic porter 8% a/v

A sweet, dark and strong ale packed with character. Brewed in honour of the winter solstice festivities. Big and bold, this ale is made with lots of chocolate malt, hints of oak and heaps of passion. The king of dark ales.

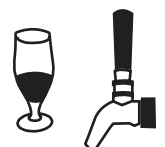

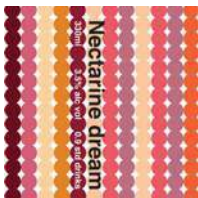


Watermelon Fruit Sour - 4.6% a/v

An absolutely beautiful sour that we dreamed up when our old neighbour said his nectarine trees were bursting with fruit he couldn't keep up with. A small seasonal sour with clean finish.

The Little Wild Muntrie - sour fruit beer 4.1% a/v

A light and tart sparkling ale made with mixed fermentation of barley malt and native muntrie berries from Robe. Our unique sour mashing technique gives this zingy ale its tartness, while the native muntrie berry gives a light and spicy apple flavour and a cloudy finish.

The Flaming Lips - ginger beer - 4 % a/v

A zesty and spicy ginger beer made with natural ginger extract and a lightly sour beer base. Not as sweet as your average ginger beer, but super tasty and refreshing! Perfect with heaps of ice in your glass for a hot summer day.

Magic Mulberry - fruit sour - 3.8% a/v

A big and tangy seasonal sparkling ale aged on tasty mulberries. Subtle mulberry flavours and a touch of malty sweetness shines through this crisp and tart drink. Perfect in a champagne flute or even over ice.

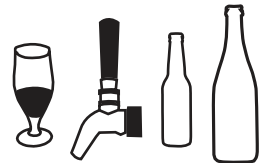

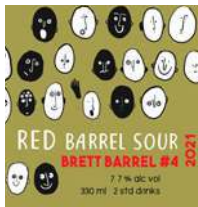


Red Barrel Sour - Blue Label 7.5% a/v

A blend of barrels #1 and #2 previously holding Montepulciano in Coonawarra. Though the wild yeast has increased its funky flavours over time, this is the lightest of this set of red barrel sours.

Red Barrel Sour - Green Label 7.7% a/v

If you like it funky, try the green label for a bigger hit of Brettanomyces yeasty funk! Still a tasty red barrel sour!

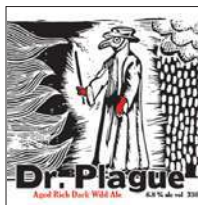


Mongrel - Brett Barrel Aged Barley Wine - 9.7% a/v

Floral, citrusy and funky, yet soo smooth! This caramel strong ale spent 6 months in ex-wine barrels, refermenting with the brettanomyces wild wine yeasts present. A beautiful mongrel of an ale to enjoy with your mongrel friends.

Dr. Plague - sour strong dark ale - 10% a/v

A very dark and strong, rich and sour ale tamed by the good Doctor for many months in tank and then bottle conditioned. Deliciously decadent with flavours of sour cherry and chocolate!
